## The following guidelines have been established for the Youth Music & Worship Arts Camp at Reinhardt University for 2019:

- Reinhardt University has a policy that e-cigarettes, vapor administering instruments, tobacco, alcohol, or non-prescribed drugs are prohibited. Any drugs being taken on a regular basis must be listed on the health form and must be discussed/given to the designated counselor at checkin. Students will be dismissed immediately from camp if found in possession of any of these items.
- Reinhardt University requires that weapons [guns, knives, box cutters, etc.] found with a student will result in immediate dismissal from camp.
- Each student will assume financial responsibility for damages caused to his/her room or elsewhere on the Reinhardt University campus.
- Mobile devices, TVs, video players and gaming systems are not allowed at camp. Offline only
  iPods and other mp3/music players are permitted but should not leave the dorm. If students
  choose not to comply, items will be confiscated and returned at the end of the week. Students
  will be given the opportunity to use the counselors' cell phones to call home upon any request.
- Desktop, laptop, tablet, ipad or other personal computing devices are only permitted on a caseby-case basis (i.e. online course work requirement, tool/instrument to enhance camp class work) and approval must be acquired before arrival at camp by contacting the Camp Director.
- For safety and liability reasons, students providing his/her own transportation to camp will not be permitted to use said transportation during camp for personal use or to transport other students.
- Students will not be permitted to leave the Reinhardt University campus during camp at any
  time unless accompanied by his/her parent. Leaving campus with a parent MUST be
  coordinated ahead of time with the Camp Director or other staff member.
- Students will respect the private space and belongings of others. This includes boys staying out of girls' rooms and girls staying out of boys' rooms.
- Students will not engage in any public display of affection and save their 'romance' for when they get home.
- Each student will attend and participate fully in all classes, rehearsals, and activities provided by the camp and staff.
- The case of a camper sent home for any reason will be reviewed by NGA FUMMWA leadership
  to determine if the camper is eligible to return the following summer or if the camper is
  permanently expelled from camp.

I have read and understand the above guidelines and do hereby agree to abide by them and uphold them. It is my understanding that failure to do so may result in my early dismissal from camp.
